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Introduction

This syllabus has been developed and Approved by **the Academic Council** of the University of World Economy and Diplomacy (UWED) for the disciplines **“Russian Language I”** and **“Russian Language I”** and serves as a unified regulatory document governing the content, structure, and organization of the educational process within these disciplines. The syllabus establishes general methodological and organizational requirements for teaching **“Russian Language I”** and **“Russian Language II”** at the university.

This syllabus is intended for undergraduate students and defines the objectives and tasks of the disciplines, the structure of the educational process, expected learning outcomes, the competencies to be developed, types of academic activities, as well as the procedures for current, intermediate, and final assessment of students' knowledge. In addition, the document outlines the teaching and methodological approaches applied in the instruction of these disciplines, as well as the principles for organizing students' independent work.

The primary objective of this syllabus is to implement unified academic standards for teaching **“Russian Language I”** and **“Russian Language II,”** ensure the quality of the educational process, and develop in students the necessary knowledge, skills, and competencies that facilitate correct, fluent, and effective communication in Russian.



1. Course Description

The curriculum of the discipline “Russian Language” reflects the strategy of teaching Russian to students with Uzbek as the language of instruction, which acquires particular relevance and significance as a means of interethnic and international communication within the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan and beyond, serving as a priority language component for personnel in the field of international relations as one of the working languages of international communication.

The content of Russian language instruction at the University of World Economy and Diplomacy is based on the main goals and objectives and includes the following components:

- spheres of communicative activity, topics, situations, communicative and social roles;
- special speech skills necessary for using Russian as a means of communication;
- linguistic knowledge that helps form speech skills (information on vocabulary, phonetics, grammar, and syntax of the language);
- a set of linguistic and country-specific knowledge about the national-cultural characteristics and realities of the country of the studied language;
- general academic knowledge and rational techniques of intellectual work, ensuring the culture of students’ educational and cognitive activities in mastering Russian and in self-improvement.

2. Course Prerequisites

No prerequisites are required for this subject.

3. Course Objectives

The discipline “Russian Language” aims to improve and develop communicative and intercultural competence and to provide professionally-oriented language training for future specialists.

The main objective of teaching Russian at the University of World Economy and Diplomacy is to develop in students the level of communicative competence necessary for intercultural communication, while simultaneously shaping and improving the personality capable of further self-education in language learning and the application of acquired knowledge in various spheres of language functioning to solve important life and professional problems.

4. Learning Outcomes

Upon completing this course during the fall semester, students are expected to acquire the following skills:

- ability to read texts and understand the main information contained therein;
- ability to independently create coherent, logical statements in accordance with the given topic and communicative purpose;
- ability to construct a monologic statement of a reproductive nature based on a read or listened text of various formal-semantic structures and communicative orientation;
- mastery of the basic Russian grammar covered in this course;
- possession of a vocabulary of at least 1,300 units as listed in the dictionary of commonly used words;
- correct use of Russian grammatical forms in speech;
- ability to answer questions on social and everyday topics;
- ability to write essays on assigned topics.

5. Independent Study and Assignments

I. Independent Study and Assignments are conducted to develop students' speech skills in this subject and involves individual preparation of oral presentations on assigned speech topics.

The main requirements for this form of independent work are: (1) delivering a report on the assigned topic; (2) assessment of work considers: independence, creativity (analytical approach, idea generation, novelty in problem setting, attention to problem-solving), (3) overall literacy and clarity of expression.

II. Students complete four independent works in the form of individual assignments no later than the specified deadline.

Students must complete all assignments on time. Late submissions are not allowed.
