1. Course Description

PEU course focuses on the practical application of principal language skills with emphasis and focuses on the basics of business writing and oral communication in business-related situations or contexts. Students are given a firm base and effective knowledge of business English.

The course provides language instruction and training in business communication, including business correspondence, negotiations, formal presentations, informal networking, business vocabulary, report and proposal writing, vocabulary for professional purposes, and reading for professional purposes.

Language skills addressed include: listening, fluency development, oral intelligibility, reading, grammar, writing, and vocabulary development.

3. Learning outcomes

The target audience of the course is students enrolled with B2+ and C1 who have solid background knowledge in academic English. At the end of the course they are expected to maintain existing level and reach B2 + or C1+ levels.

After the successful completion of the course, students will be able to develop:

- Comprehend vocabulary in and from context;

Listening skills-

- Listen and read for specific information, gist, key ideas, general ideas, and understand implied ideas in the lectures;
- Listen and identify speakers in a telephone conversation, listen for attitude and numerical information and check information and make small talk

Speaking skills-

- Interpret and present information in graphs and charts and describe statistical trends and products;
- Make contrasts, comparison, requests, persuade and complain on different topics;
- Provide suggestions and recommendations and talk about advantages and disadvantages ;
- Express opinion, tendencies, cause and effect, and reasons;

Writing skills-

- Categorize and use formal and informal registers;

Write descriptions, definitions, e-mails, memos, reports, business and information letters;

1. Course description

This course introduces students to the concept of management systems, exploring classical principles, approaches, methods and models of decision-making within business structures. The curriculum covers major management schools of thought, analytical frameworks for assessing a company's micro and macro environment, core managerial functions, key leadership theories and essential aspects of human resource management. The course focuses on analyzing real business cases to help students apply management theory in practice and improve their analytical, critical and creative thinking skills.

In particular, within the framework of the presented course, it is planned to strengthen the main theoretical materials through 6 cases. Current assessment (CA) includes both individual (oral/written essay) and group (group discussion and presentation) work. Also, for the intermediate control (IC), the student is expected to prepare individually on the selected special literature - the assessment is carried out in the writing form of a test/open questions.

1. Course description

This subject is aimed at students' mastering theoretical knowledge that reveals the dynamics of consumer behavior and well-being, the most important relationships and interactions between economic parameters of a company's activities. As a result of studying microeconomics, students will gain a general understanding of the main categories and postulates, economic tools and models used to analyze the formation and state of markets, state policy, the behavior of economic agents, learn to work independently with scientific articles and reports, and analyze the consequences of various economic decisions from the point of view of economic efficiency and social justice. In addition, attention is paid to the application of knowledge and skills in solving problems arising at the microeconomic level.

2. Course pre-requisites

No prerequisites are required for this subject.

3. Course objectives

The purpose of the subject is to explain to students the essence and specific features of the mechanism of functioning of a market economy at the micro level, to familiarize them with the scientific foundations of the activities (behavior) of economic agents, and to form knowledge and skills for applying it in practice in order to make optimal economic decisions in various economic conditions.

4. Learning outcomes

Upon successful completion of this subject, students will acquire the following skills:

1. Explain economic phenomena based on microeconomic laws;
2. Apply the knowledge gained, forms and methods of economic management in the current economic conditions;
3. Make rational economic decisions and use economic knowledge in professional activities, calculate the main economic indicators that assess the activities of the enterprise;
4. Analyze market development trends and show ways to increase the competitiveness of enterprises in this market;
5. Be able to foresee the consequences of decisions being made, and make suggestions and recommendations to reduce potential risks.

5. Independent learning and assignments


Independent work is carried out in order to deepen students' knowledge of Macroeconomics, and the chapters of the main literature listed in the syllabus on the subject are independently studied by the student in depth. In order to check the knowledge of the students on the topic they have studied, the teacher answers questions in practical lessons. In addition, due to the large amount of graphical information in the subject, each student is required to submit a summary.

Students' mastery of knowledge and summaries of each topic, as well as their activity in the lesson, affect their overall grade.

Students must submit all assignments on time. Resubmission of assignments that have been missed is not allowed.

3.Course objectives

The purpose of the course "*Quantitative Methods in Economics*" is to develop students' logical, algorithmic, and abstract thinking, to foster mathematical reasoning, and to train them to clearly and convincingly express their own ideas, opinions, and conclusions. It also aims to form practical skills and competencies based on the knowledge acquired.

In addition, the course teaches students to master and apply the mathematical apparatus necessary for solving theoretical and practical economic problems, as well as to construct and analyze mathematical models of economic tasks.

4. Learning Outcomes

Students will be able to:

- solve linear programming problems;
- solve transportation problems;
- solve nonlinear programming problems;
- solve matrix game problems;
- express conclusions clearly.

5. Independent learning and assignments

Independent work is carried out with the purpose of deepening students' knowledge of this subject.

The assignments consist of individually prepared problems and theoretical questions for each student, organized by topic. They are designed to apply the methods studied in this course to practical economic problems and include the following:

1. Matrices and operations on them. Solving systems of linear equations.
2. Solving economic problems that can be formulated as linear programming tasks.
3. Applying linear algebra methods to solve optimal planning and allocation problems.
4. Solving economic problems that can be formulated within game theory and making optimal decisions.

1.Course description

In this course, students will be introduced to the basic principles and programming environment of the Python programming language, which is considered a modern and universal programming language. During the course, fundamental concepts such as variables, data types, operators, branching and iterative operators, strings, lists, sets, arrays, functions, and recursion will be studied. Students will also gain skills in working with files, working with Python's standard library, modules such as math, datetime, and random. The principles of object-oriented programming - classes, objects, inheritance, and multiple inheritance - will also be covered. At the end of the course, students will gain practical skills in performing mathematical and statistical operations using the NumPy library, generating pseudo-random numbers, and working with data sets (DataFrames) using the Pandas library, analyzing them, and processing them.

2. The initial requisites of science

No prerequisites are required for this subject.

3. Purpose of the Course

The purpose of the course is to develop practical skills in the effective use of the Python programming language and modern information and communication technologies (ICT) tools in socio-economic areas, in working with data, analyzing and visualizing them. This course will provide students with a foundation for mastering such subjects as statistical analysis, database work, and economic modeling at the next stages of their studies in the fields of International Economics and Management.

4. Learning outcomes

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1) They will gain a general understanding of programming fundamentals, modern programming languages, and the Python language;
- 2) They will learn how to process, store, and analyze data using the Python programming language;
- 3) They will acquire skills in planning, writing code, testing, and launching simple software projects;
- 4) They perform data analysis and visualization using Python libraries (e.g. pandas, numpy) .

5. Independent learning and assignments

1. Course Description

The course structure is based on two approaches. The first approach is cumulative, introducing the theory and practice of research step by step into the content of the academic subject. The second concerns the involvement of students in practical work to develop the skills necessary for obtaining a quality end product.

- understand geostrategic factors in conducting situational or event analysis through different critical forms of thinking, discussing the opponent's academic view, and expressing his opinion about it;

5. Independent learning and assignments

I. Independent learning is carried out to deepen students' knowledge of the course. It includes individual study of the primary and additional literature necessary for case-study analysis and project work.

The main requirements for independent learning for students are as follows: (1) analysis of the given case-studies and SWOT-analysis; (2) the following are taken into account when evaluating tasks: independence, creativity (analytical approach, generation of ideas, novelty of problem setting, attention to problem solving), reasonableness of proposed rules; (3) stylistics (general literacy, ensuring ease of understanding texts); (4) consistency of presentation.

II. Students perform independent tasks (7) in the form of individual assignments no later than the indicated deadline (a case-study analysis, compiling a glossary of terminology for new types of diplomacy (30 words), using social media in diplomacy (students' presentations), analysis of social media pages of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and its diplomatic missions abroad (comparative analysis), A SWOT-analysis, individual project work).

1.Course description

Sustainability science has emerged in recent years as a new scientific discipline, at the interface between environmental science and sustainable development. Key objectives of the discipline are to develop an understanding of the basics of human-environment systems and explore current dynamics. Within the course we will examine the sustainability approaches in solving development issues in different regions of the world and look at the most and least sustainable practices in those regions.

Sustainable development is defined as “development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs” (Brundtland Report, 1987) and evidences an increasing interest and concern about the management of environmental resources worldwide. Whereas sustainable development remains an almost abstract concept that is never straightforward to implement, it is broadly described in terms of striking the right balance between economic growth, improved social welfare and environmental protection.

This course is designed to allow students to explore the frontiers of knowledge in sustainability science through lectures, directed reading materials/videos, problem-based learning and group projects.

2.Course pre-requisites

3.Course objectives

The course is meant to offer an opportunity for candidates that may not have prior knowledge of sustainability science, to study a range of environmental issues from a scientific perspective. Although other dimensions (such as social, cultural, economic and political aspects) may be considered, the course primarily seeks to provide scientific knowledge and understanding enabling the students to review environmental issues as an important aspect of sustainable development more objectively. This would enable them to assess the dimension of the issue and to consider alternative strategies for its resolution.

The course seeks to provide basic environmental literacy and sustainability science for candidates who would later pursue a wide variety of careers, but it is also meant to encourage and provide basic knowledge to others who would opt for careers directly related to the environmental field. To promote a more holistic framework of sustainability issues, the approach adopted must necessarily be interdisciplinary, involving inputs from various fields related to the issues being studied. While ensuring that the course provides a global perspective, candidates will be also encouraged to explore with the local and regional dimensions of the environmental issues being studied.

4.Learning outcomes

The course seeks to help students to:

- acquire and apply scientific knowledge about environmental issues in order to understand the underlying scientific concepts;
- develop a deeper understanding of environmental issues by relating scientific

knowledge with other perspectives,;

- acquire the necessary problem-solving skills that would enable them to examine and propose alternatives to a variety of environmental problems;
- develop pro-environmental values and attitudes that foster environmental responsibility;
- critically evaluate their attitudes, behavior and values and consequently adopt a more sustainable lifestyle.

5. Independent learning and assignments

Independent work is designed to deepen students' understanding of the subject. It requires students to search, select, analyze, and study materials on themes recommended by the instructor and posted on the course Moodle platform.

Assignment 1.

Based on the materials posted on Moodle, each student independently selects a topic related to the world economy. Using textbooks and learning resources, the student collects, analyzes, and organizes the information to prepare the theoretical part of a scholarly essay. This part of the essay must demonstrate familiarity with the works of well-known scholars, the ability to analyze and systematize existing sources, to provide critical evaluations, and to highlight the most significant ideas and arguments.

Assignment 2.

Building on the first assignment, students prepare the applied (analytical) part of the essay. For this task, students are expected to use academic articles published in reputable journals (e.g., indexed in Google Scholar) relevant to their chosen topic. The applied section should demonstrate the student's ability to apply theories studied in class, analyze real-world cases, and make use of statistical data and research methods from credible sources.

Students are required to complete two individual assignments within the specified deadlines. These assignments should reflect the ability to independently investigate an economic problem, reach well-founded conclusions, and propose constructive recommendations for improvement.

Assignments submitted form part of the ongoing assessment of the course and will be graded accordingly. All assignments must be submitted on time. Late submissions will not be accepted.

Attendance Policy

Students are expected to attend class regularly. Failure to attend class regularly may result in a reduction of the student's overall grade.

1.Course Description

The “**Macroeconomics**” course covers the application of macroeconomic analysis to government policy. This course presents the main concepts and issues of macroeconomics, as well as the fundamentals of conducting macroeconomic policy. Topics include methods for calculating macroeconomic indicators, various models of macroeconomic equilibrium, fiscal and monetary directions of macroeconomic policy, issues of economic growth, balance of payments, and exchange rates.

2. Course pre-requisites

Microeconomics

3.Course Objectives

The course aims to develop students’ skills in applying macroeconomic analysis tools and constructing macroeconomic models, solving quantitative and qualitative problems, and conducting research and economic analysis.

4. Learning Outcomes

By successfully completing this course, students will acquire the following skills:

1. Demonstrate knowledge of the fundamental concepts of macroeconomics.
2. Understand the laws governing the functioning of the modern economy at the macro level.
3. Explain factors affecting economic growth using neoclassical models.
4. Analyze economic conditions in the short and long-term using macroeconomic equilibrium models (Keynesian model, AD/AS; IS/LM) and represent them graphically.
5. Assess the impact of monetary and fiscal policy on macroeconomic variables and evaluate their interactions.
6. Explain the balance of payments, its components, exchange rates, and the factors influencing them.
7. Identify economic development issues in different countries using international statistical data to determine and compare trends in economic indicators such as economic growth, employment, inflation, government debt, money supply, exchange rates, and reserve changes.

5. Independent Study and Self-Directed Work

Independent work is conducted to deepen students’ knowledge of the Macroeconomics course. Students study the relevant chapters of the main literature listed in the syllabus independently and in depth. To assess students’ understanding of the topics, assignments are given for each topic, which must be submitted on the Moodle system before the specified deadline. Written assignments are graded up to 4 points.

In addition, oral questions and answers are conducted on the studied topics and graded up to 6 points. Students' mastery of each topic and participation in class affect their overall grade.

1. The course description

The marketing course is aimed at providing students with an understanding of the principles of Marketing and focuses on the management of the marketing activities and how marketing relates to overall organisational functioning. Such topics as branding and product development, pricing strategies, marketing research, promotion are included.

2. The course prerequisites

3. The course objective

The course is aimed at equipping students with the fundamentals of marketing, forming competencies to apply international marketing tools in them, to ensure that they have a deep understanding of the categorical apparatus of the science and being able to apply it correctly in practice, developing critical evaluation skills of the phenomena dealing with offering products to consumers.

4. Learning outcomes

By the end of the course the students will be able:

1. to assess market potential, understand and analyze customer behavior, and focus resources on specific customer segments;
2. to develop a new product and to take effective decisions dealing with branding
3. to set the most efficient prices for the goods and services to be offered to the consumers;
4. to understand the role of distributors, retailers, and other intermediaries in delivering products;
5. to develop an effective mix of communication efforts.

5. Independent learning and assignments

During the course, students independently prepare 5 tasks and submit them within the specified time limits:

Assignment 1. Students will independently study the chosen topic within the scope of marketing and make a presentation in the form of a team of 2-3 students. The students will be provided with the list of the topic for independent learning.

In addition, students are required to submit the following three individual tasks in the form of an essay:

Essay 1. The branding strategy of a certain company in Uzbekistan. You are required to choose a company operating in Uzbekistan and give an overview of the branding strategy of the company. You are required to pay attention to the following aspects while writing an essay:

Give a brief information about the operation of the company you have selected and the products offered by the company.

Explain the branding strategy that is used by the company.

Essay 2. The changing marketing landscape in the era of digitalization. You are required to pay attention to the following aspects while writing an essay:

Provide a detailed comparison of the traditional marketing landscape and the one in the new digital era;

Explain your answer in an example of the marketing tools used by a certain company operating in Uzbekistan.

Essay 3. Why to hire a marketing specialist in 2024? You are required to pay attention to the following aspects while writing an essay:

Specify the general qualities and expertise that employers value in marketing specialists today.

Give an example a certain product or service offered in Uzbekistan to explain the importance of a marketing specialist in promoting it.

In the middle of semester students are required to take a midterm exam consisting of multiple choice questions.

At the end of the course, students are required to submit project work on a marketing plan for offering a good or service (with concept and practical part) working in teams of maximum 3-4 students each.

The students who fail to obtain at least 60% (36 points) of the total points (60 points) allocated for active participation of students in classes, the relevant assignments will not be allowed to enter the final exam for the course.

Detailed evaluation criteria for each assignment are uploaded onto the corresponding platform. Students must complete the assignments within the terms set by the teacher. It is strictly forbidden to violate the rules of etiquette established in the appropriate order at the University. In case the plagiarism is revealed the corresponding work will be evaluated with 0 point.



1. Course description

The course is intended for students studying probability theory and mathematical statistics in the field of economics and management. This subject teaches students study the laws of random events, random variables and distribution functions. Draw conclusions and make decisions in cases where there are random influences. It teaches how to put statistical data into a certain mathematical system and draw scientific and practical conclusions using statistical data. The study of this subject provides the necessary knowledge for studying the course "Econometrics". In teaching this subject, special attention is paid to the analysis and forecasting of economic process.

2. Course pre-requisites

Studying the discipline should be based on the knowledge, skills and competencies acquired in the process of studying the disciplines "Calculus-1" and "Calculus-II" **CALC12C6**.

3. Learning outcomes

Upon successful completion of this subject, students will acquire the following skills:

1. Calculate the probability of random events occurring in economics and apply the laws of large numbers to this process;
2. Construct the law of sample distribution and calculate its main quantitative indicators;
3. Calculate the numerical characteristics of the distributions of discrete and continuous random variables;
4. Calculate correlations between random variables and use them to determine economic development trends;
5. Can calculate the correlation coefficient and construct linear regression;
6. Know how to construct polynomials, histograms, confidence intervals;
7. Could test hypotheses and predict the future using economic data;
8. Can interpret and summarize the results of the analysis.

5. Independent learning and assignments

Independent work is carried out in order to deepen students' knowledge of this subject. Assignments consist of problems and theoretical questions prepared individually for each student on the topic. They consist of problems designed to apply the science of probability and statistics to economic problems in 3 area:

1. Probability theory. Random events. Solving economic problems.
2. Random quantities. Solving economic problems;
3. Mathematical statistics. Solving economic problems;

All assignments are organized through the university's LMS system, and students must upload completed assignment answers (in PDF format) to the system within 1 week. Resubmission of missed assignments is not allowed.



1. Course description

Within the framework of the curriculum, "International Tourism" is a field of science that comprehensively studies travel conducted beyond national borders, its economic, social, cultural, political, and environmental impacts, the formation, development, and management systems of international tourism flows, as well as processes related to cooperation between different countries, the global tourism market, and the activities of international organizations, including the role and potential of Uzbekistan in the world tourism system.

2. Course pre-requisites

Prerequisites are not required for this course.

3. The objective of the course

The main goal of studying the subject is to form a systematic vision among students regarding global processes in the tourism sector and to prepare qualified specialists who can operate effectively in the international tourism environment, and who are capable of developing and implementing tourism products based on international standards and trends.

4. Learning outcomes

Students who master this subject will possess the following knowledge, skills, and competencies:

- understand the basic concepts, principles, and stages of development of international tourism;
- gain an understanding of the world tourism market, its structure, and its participants;
- analyze the political, economic, environmental, and social factors affecting international tourism;
- evaluate the tourism resources and potential of different regions and countries;
- know how to work with legislation and regulatory documents governing international tourism activities;
- analyze the place of Uzbekistan in the international tourism system and provide proposals for its development;
- acquire practical skills in developing and implementing competitive tourism products in the field of international tourism;
- understand the activities of international organizations (UN World Tourism Organization, UNESCO, etc.) and evaluate their impact on tourism.

5. Independent learning and assignments

Independent work helps students master lecture materials more deeply and develops core professional and academic competencies that allow for the analysis of processes in the tourism sector and the comparison of trends in the development of states, regions, and tourism. Critical thinking is developed: skills in defining problems, identifying causes, and proposing solutions are formed (for example, in the context of sustainable tourism or crisis conditions).

As part of their independent work, students apply theoretical knowledge to practice, conduct research based on a selected topic, prepare presentations, and solve problem-based issues. Tasks may be presented in both written and oral forms.

Assignments for independent education in the "International Tourism" course:

- Analysis of a country's tourism potential;
- Comparative analysis of tourist flows;

- Research on the tourist specialization of a region;
- Case assignment: organizing an international tour;
- Tourism in the context of global challenges.

1. Course description

Within this course, students will gain a deep understanding of the subject and objectives of the “Green Economy” course, its role in economic science, and the theoretical and methodological foundations for studying the principles and mechanisms of managing green development in the modern economy. The purpose of mastering the “Green Economy” course is to provide students with a general understanding of the green economy in the contemporary world, its implementation in various countries and in Uzbekistan, its essence, and the conditions for developing economic sectors in a sustainable and environmentally friendly manner.

2. Course pre-requisites

No prerequisites are required for this course.

3. Course objective

The objective of the course is to provide comprehensive knowledge on understanding the “green” economy in the modern world, the features of international legal regulation, and the foundations for creating and operating a green economy in Uzbekistan. It also focuses on understanding its content in relation to the development of national economic sectors and on developing practical skills in the field of the green economy.

4. Learning outcomes

Upon successful completion of this course, students will acquire the following skills:

1. The ability to search for information, perform critical analysis and synthesis, and apply a systematic approach to solving assigned problems.
2. The ability to use local and foreign sources to collect necessary data, analyze it, and prepare informational reviews and analytical reports for solving professional problems.
3. Knowledge of the fundamentals of creating and managing a “green” economy, as well as methods for developing management decision options in business and justifying their selection based on the principles of the green economy.
4. The ability to develop mechanisms for implementing ecological and economic policies at various levels, and to evaluate proposed measures, projects, and activities considering their socio-economic and environmental consequences.
5. The ability to use general scientific methods—systematic, comparative, and general logical methods—as well as empirical methods such as surveys, observations, and document analysis, for analysis, synthesis, induction, and critical thinking.
6. Practical skills to assess the effectiveness of proposed measures and projects, taking into account their socio-economic and environmental impacts.

5. Independent learning and assignments

To deepen their knowledge, students are required to engage in independent study, which involves studying the relevant chapters of the main and additional literature listed in the curriculum. During the course, students are also expected to complete practical assignments aimed at developing skills in sustainable development, ecological and economic analysis, and evaluation of green strategies. These assignments include:

- Evaluating the principles and objectives of the green economy (essay, 2–3 pages).
- Analysis of the “green” sector of the national economy (brief SWOT analysis).
- Developing a green project concept (short project, 4–5 pages + oral presentation).
- Comparing green strategies of different countries (comparative table + analytical note, 3 pages).
- Economic evaluation of ecosystem services (report, 4–5 pages + tables with calculations/assessments).

All assignments are organized through the university Moodle system, and students must submit their completed assignments (in PDF format) within one week. All assignments must be submitted on time; late submissions will not be accepted or re-evaluated.

1. Course description

Based on the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. PF-5850 dated December 21, 2019, "On measures to radically increase the prestige and status of the Uzbek language as a state language," and Decree No. PF-6084 dated October 20, 2020, "On measures to further develop the Uzbek language and improve language policy in our country," as well as the resolution "On approval of the Concept for the development of the higher education system of the Republic of Uzbekistan until 2030," it is appropriate to organize language teaching based on a new approach to increase the quality and efficiency of language education. The "Concept for the development of the Uzbek language and improvement of language policy in 2020-2030" sets the task of "further improving the state language teaching system in educational organizations and increasing its prestige as a language of science" by "establishing a system for teaching the subject 'Application of the Uzbek Language and Speech Culture in the Field' in state higher education institutions where education is conducted in other languages."

To this end, the subject "Speech Culture and the Art of Oratory for Specialists" is recommended as an elective for students of the University of World Economy and Diplomacy. The program includes knowledge on politics, economics, and language—their mutual relationship—speech culture and the art of oratory, communicative classification of the speech of political scientists, lawyers, and economists, the history of oratory development, mastery of speech techniques and extralinguistic tools for diplomats, methods of using "black rhetoric," psychological foundations of the art of oratory, speech skills, and specific aspects of an orator's speech.

The teaching of this subject consists of forming knowledge, skills, and competencies in theoretical and practical aspects, including speech culture and oratory, the expression of the history of oratory in the mirror of speech practice and culture, the communicative classification of a specialist's speech, historical stages of oratory, methods of mastering speech techniques and skillful use of the voice, and the psychological and extralinguistic foundations of speech.

The main tasks of the subject:

- To form an understanding among specialists of the factors that create the communicative qualities of speech;
- To strengthen knowledge and skills regarding paying close attention to speech and mastering the skills of constructing written and oral speech based on creating a scientific-analytical understanding of speech culture, purity, effectiveness, appropriateness, accuracy, and logic, and especially speech correctness;
- To form the ability to masterfully use lexical-grammatical, spelling, phonetic, orthographic, and pronunciation factors during the speech process according to the requirements of the situation and reality;
- To form and improve the skill of using professional speech in various situations, applying field-specific knowledge in practice, and speaking in accordance with language norms;
- To create opportunities for expressing oral speech at a high level;
- To educate the thinking talent of students and increase their potential to speak masterfully about content.

2. Course prerequisites

3. Course objectives

The objective of the subject is to form practical skills aimed at developing students' professional communication skills, the ability to correctly use speech in legal situations related to any foreign policy or foreign economic status, increasing pragmatic efficiency in the process of entering communication, forming the skill of highly accurate and rational use of literary language tools, the ability to create texts in accordance with logical-semantic and linguistic norms, and developing the potential for effective communication with the population.

Tasks of the module:

- To form an understanding among specialists of the factors that create the communicative qualities of speech;
- To form practical knowledge on speech culture, the art of oratory, and communication culture, and to introduce the norms and criteria of speech;
- To strengthen knowledge and skills regarding written and oral speech construction based on a scientific-analytical understanding of speech purity, effectiveness, appropriateness, accuracy, logic, and especially correctness;
- To form the skill of constructing pragmatic speech (oral and written) for students of various fields and to develop different communication skills in various situations using language units appropriately in professional speech;
- To form the ability to skillfully use lexical-grammatical, spelling, phonetic, and pronunciation factors during the speech process according to the situation;
- To improve the skill of applying professional speech and field-specific knowledge in accordance with language norms;
- To create opportunities for high-level oral expression;
- To educate students' thinking talent and increase their potential for masterful speaking.

4. Learning outcomes

As a result of mastering the subject, the student will:

- possess scientific-theoretical knowledge regarding the subject of oratory, criteria of speech culture, and linguistic and extralinguistic aspects of speech;
- possess the skill to perfectly construct a text for a public lecture;
- form polemical skills in communication;
- acquire the skill to construct correct and effective speech;
- be able to express their thoughts at a high level while observing the norms of the literary language;
- learn to use the descriptive tools of language in communication;
- possess skills to identify factors that have a negative impact during the speech process and how to overcome them;
- acquire the skills to work with media materials, write notes, analyses, and articles, and summarize, expand, shorten, and conclude information;

- master the speech techniques of an international field specialist, forming the skill to use extralinguistic tools and all types of rhetoric;
- learn the requirements of formal speech in a professionally oriented language;
- be able to express thoughts at the required level (orally and in writing);
- know how to appropriately use language styles in professional activities;
- correctly apply the lexical and terminological norms of speech;

5. Independent learning and assignments

Course Description

The main objective of the course “Second Foreign Language 1” is to provide future economists, diplomats, and lawyers with knowledge of the normative rules of the phonetic, grammatical, and lexical systems of the modern literary foreign language. It is the first course of four students will take in a second foreign language. The course aims to develop students’ oral and written communication skills and to build proficiency in accordance with the norms of the literary language.

The program is designed with a focus on communication. It is structured to develop students’ competencies in socio-political, popular scientific, and journalistic contexts, as well as within their chosen fields of specialization and future professional activities. The course “Second Foreign Language” is designed for four semesters.

The primary goal of language instruction at the university is to develop sufficient communicative competence for intercultural communication, while forming and enhancing individuals who are able not only to work in a foreign language in the future, but also to use it effectively in solving important real-life tasks.

Course Prerequisites

No prerequisites are required for this course.

Course Objectives

The course “Second Foreign Language 1” course is not directly linked to the production process. However, it plays a significant role in training qualified specialists at the University of World Economy and Diplomacy who meet international standards in all respects.

At all stages of education, the primary goal of foreign language teaching is to develop students’ communicative competence in a foreign language, enabling them to operate in everyday, academic, and professional spheres within a multicultural world.

Foreign language communicative competence is defined as the ability to apply acquired knowledge, skills, and abilities in the target language during the process of communication.

“Second Foreign Language 1” course is an independent and complete program with its own content and structural organization.

Grammar (morphology and syntax) is studied in close connection with vocabulary. In the first semester of the second year, the foundations of grammar are

covered. Classroom activities, based on the objectives of each lesson and ongoing assessment requirements, include:

- Question-and-answer activities and thorough study of new vocabulary
- Gap-filling exercises
- Sentence completion tasks
- Discussion of the text read in dialogue form
- Role-playing activities
- Oral retelling of the text read
- Commentary on read or listened texts
- Prepared or impromptu presentations on specific topics

Learning Outcomes

By the end of the first semester of the second year, students are expected to achieve A1 level proficiency and demonstrate the following:

Vocabulary should consist of approximately 600 lexical items and phraseological expressions.

1. Course Description

The main objective of the course “Second Foreign Language 1” is to provide future economists, diplomats, and lawyers with knowledge of the normative rules of the phonetic, grammatical, and lexical systems of the modern literary foreign language. It is the first course of four students will take in a second foreign language. The course aims to develop students’ oral and written communication skills and to build proficiency in accordance with the norms of the literary language.

The program is designed with a focus on communication. It is structured to develop students’ competencies in socio-political, popular scientific, and journalistic contexts, as well as within their chosen fields of specialization and future professional activities. The course “Second Foreign Language” is designed for four semesters.

The primary goal of language instruction at the university is to develop sufficient communicative competence for intercultural communication, while forming and enhancing individuals who are able not only to work in a foreign language in the future, but also to use it effectively in solving important real-life tasks.

2. Course Prerequisites

No prerequisites are required for this course.

3. Course Objectives

The course “Second Foreign Language 1” course is not directly linked to the production process. However, it plays a significant role in training qualified specialists at the University of World Economy and Diplomacy who meet international standards in all respects.

At all stages of education, the primary goal of foreign language teaching is to develop students’ communicative competence in a foreign language,

enabling them to operate in everyday, academic, and professional spheres within a multicultural world.

Foreign language communicative competence is defined as the ability to apply acquired knowledge, skills, and abilities in the target language during the process of communication.

“Second Foreign Language 1” course is an independent and complete program with its own content and structural organization.

Grammar (morphology and syntax) is studied in close connection with vocabulary. In the first semester of the second year, the foundations of grammar are covered. Classroom activities, based on the objectives of each lesson and ongoing assessment requirements, include:

- Question-and-answer activities and thorough study of new vocabulary
- Gap-filling exercises
- Sentence completion tasks
- Discussion of the text read in dialogue form
- Role-playing activities
- Oral retelling of the text read
- Commentary on read or listened texts
- Prepared or impromptu presentations on specific topics

4. Learning Outcomes

By the end of the first semester of the second year, students are expected to achieve A1 level proficiency and demonstrate the following:

Vocabulary should consist of approximately 600 lexical items and phraseological expressions.


