REGULATIONS

on

Inclusive Media Club and “Inclusive Volunteers” Group

These Regulations were approved by Order No. 1-2-UM of the Rector of the University of World Economy and Diplomacy dated 6 January 2026.

These Regulations establish the principal objectives, tasks, areas of activity, and organisational and legal framework for the operation of the Inclusive Media Club and the “Inclusive Volunteers” Group at the University of World Economy and Diplomacy. They are aimed at providing social, spiritual and educational, and psychological support to University students, promoting their initiative and public engagement, and fostering an environment of cooperation, mutual respect, and healthy communication.

The Regulations set out the core principles governing the activities of the Club and the Group, including legality, voluntary participation, equality, openness, mutual respect, responsibility, confidentiality, and compliance with the University’s internal rules and regulations. Respect for the honour, dignity, rights, and legitimate interests of persons participating in the activities of the Club and the Group, as well as the maintenance of a healthy and safe social and psychological environment, is identified as one of the key priorities.

This document regulates the principal objectives and tasks of the Club and the Group, the forms of their activities, the procedures for admission to and termination of membership, the rights and responsibilities of members, and the mechanisms for managing and coordinating their activities. The Regulations provide for the organisation of meetings, round-table discussions, seminars, training sessions, spiritual and educational events, psychological counselling, social projects, and other relevant activities.

The activities of the Club and the Group are intended to develop teamwork among students, support the meaningful organisation of their free time, facilitate the timely identification of problems and their resolution with the assistance of relevant specialists, and create favourable conditions for students’ social adaptation and personal development.

Overall supervision of the activities of the Club and the Group is carried out by the advisers. The advisers ensure that activities are organised in accordance with the established objectives and tasks, that members receive methodological and practical support, that events are conducted effectively and to a high standard, and that the University’s internal documents are complied with.

The activities of the Club and the Group are coordinated in cooperation with the [Office of Youth Affairs](#) and the [Five Important Initiatives Center](#) of the University of World Economy and Diplomacy, as well as the [University Psychologist](#). Within their respective mandates, these structural units provide organisational, methodological, informational, and advisory support, participate in the

implementation of joint events and projects, and contribute to improving the effectiveness of the activities.

The Regulations also establish the procedure for planning the activities of the Club and the Group, compiling relevant information on activities conducted, analysing the results of their activities, and establishing cooperation with the University's responsible structural units. Throughout these activities, the University's reputation and corporate values must be upheld, and its standards of conduct and ethics and internal rules and regulations must be strictly observed.
