## Executive Summary

In 2025, the University of World Economy and Diplomacy demonstrated **strong research performance** and academic productivity. The reporting results show continued growth in scientific publications, international indexing, academic monographs, scientific conferences, and the development of research outputs across key disciplinary fields.

The [Office of Postgraduate Education](#) contributes to the coordination of postgraduate and research-related processes by supporting dissertation-related activities, doctoral and independent research pathways, scientific seminars, and the institutional monitoring of research outputs. The indicators presented in this report reflect UWED's commitment to research excellence, academic integrity, international visibility, and the development of scientific capacity.

During the reporting period, UWED academic staff published **420** scientific articles, including **24** articles indexed in the Scopus database. In addition, **30** academic monographs were published, contributing to in-depth theoretical and applied studies in key disciplines. The University also organised and hosted **22** scientific conferences, creating platforms for scholarly exchange, international cooperation and policy-oriented discussion.

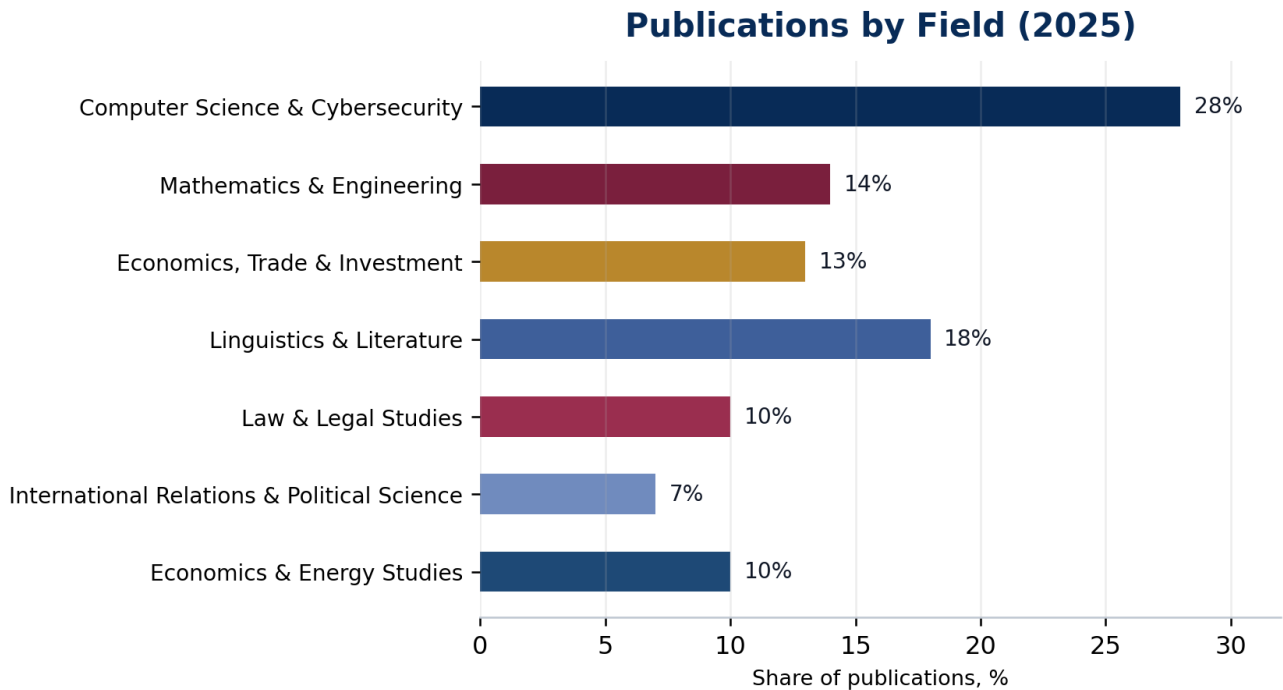
## Research Coordination and Quality Assurance

UWED has established monitoring and incentive mechanisms for faculty publications indexed in Scopus and Web of Science databases. The indexing status of publications and the journal quartile ranking (Q1-Q4) are verified according to established procedures, and appropriate incentives are provided to authors based on the results.

These mechanisms support the University's commitment to producing research that directly contributes to its mission of educating professionals for international engagement. UWED continues to prioritise research excellence as a central pillar of its academic identity and actively fosters an institutional culture of innovation, scholarly integrity and global relevance.

## Publications by Field

The chart below presents the distribution of Scopus-indexed research articles by field in 2025. The distribution demonstrates the interdisciplinary nature of UWED research and its relevance to priority areas of global policy, law, economics, language studies, cybersecurity and international relations.

## Research Dissemination and Digital Repository

In addition to international research dissemination, UWED maintains a strong presence through faculty-authored academic proceedings that are regularly published, archived and shared nationally. These outputs promote knowledge exchange within Uzbekistan’s higher education ecosystem through digital educational materials and institutional repository services.

UWED lecturers publish research outputs, including proceedings related to master’s, PhD and doctoral works, as well as scholarly articles, through the University’s official digital repository and library services. This approach strengthens national academic integration and aligns research outputs with Uzbekistan’s strategic priorities in science, education and foreign policy.

## Financial Background of Academic and Research Programmes

UWED academic programmes and research-related projects are financially supported through various local and international sources. The funding portfolio demonstrates the University's capacity to support academic development, research activity, digital transformation and international cooperation.
