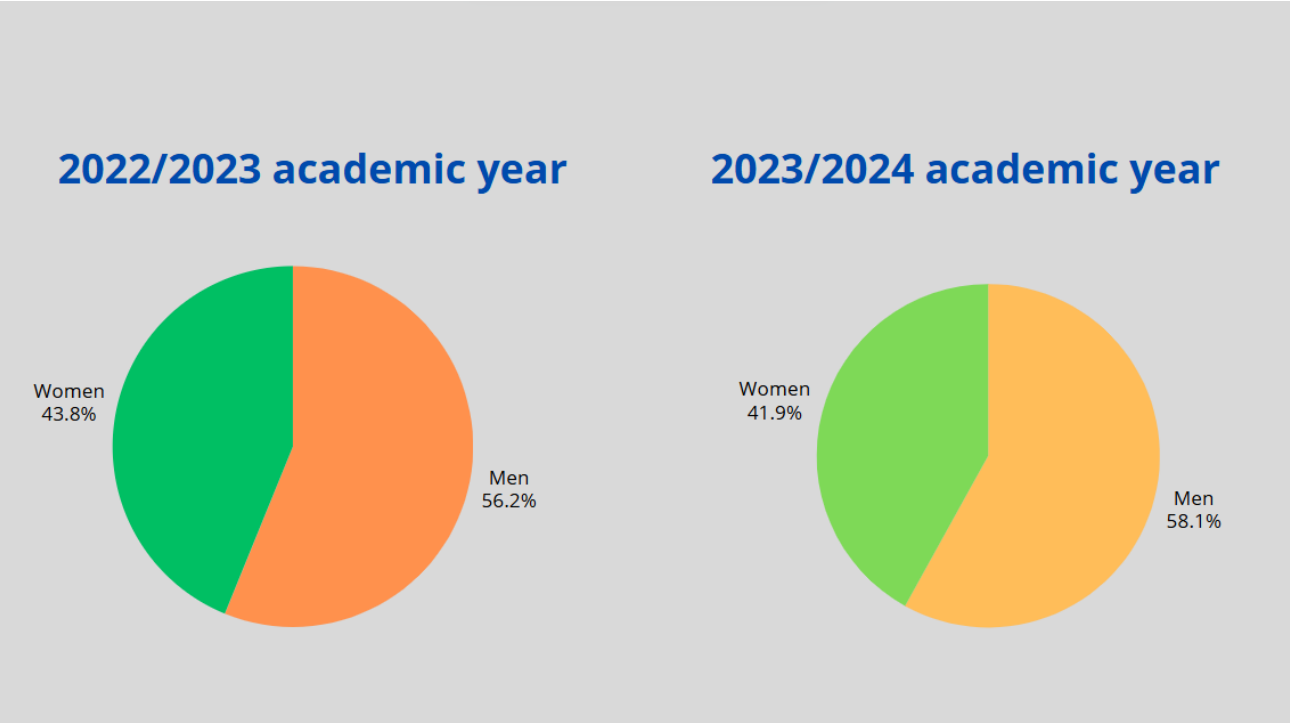


# Gender differences in graduating students at the UWED

Over the past two years, the following changes have been observed in the percentage of women graduating from the UWED:

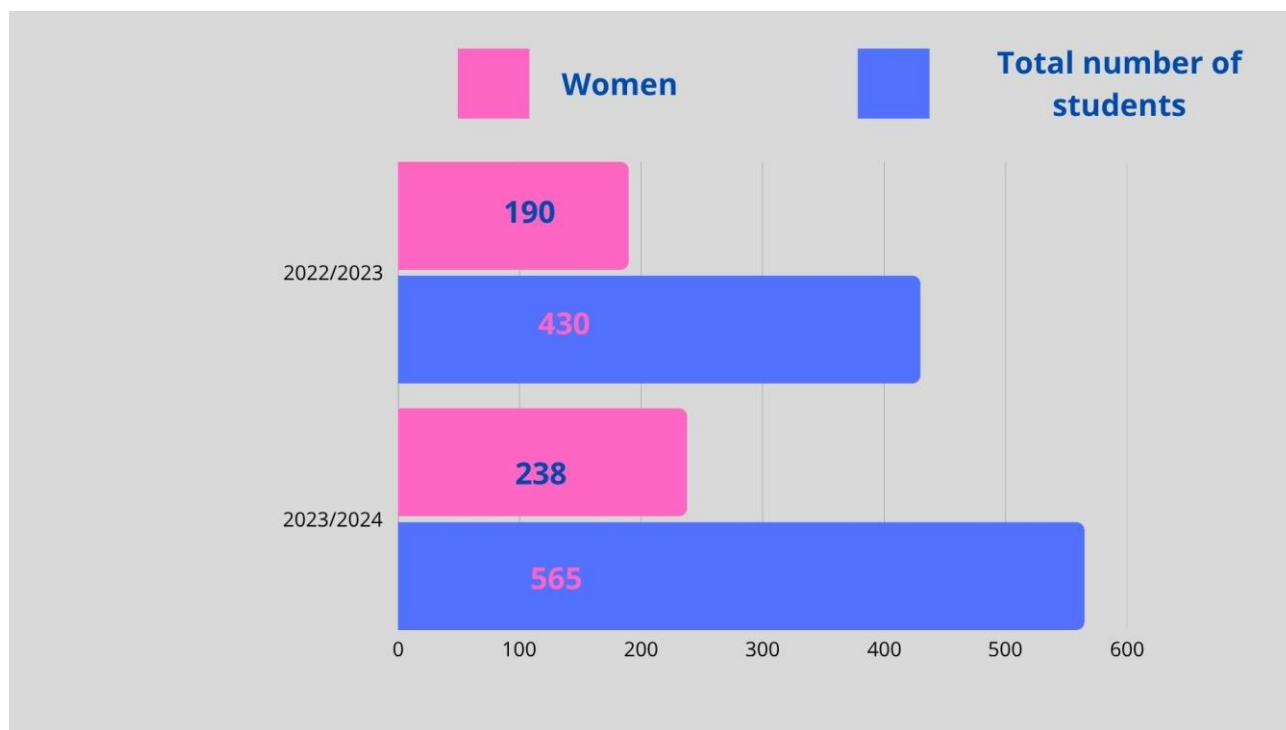
- 2022/2023 academic year: 44.2% women, 55.8% men
- 2023/2024 academic year: 42.1% women, 57.9% men



## Total number of graduated students (by female/male)

The number of female and male students graduating from the University of World Economy and Diplomacy is as follows:

Academic year	Number of women	Number of men	Total number of students
2022/2023	192	246	438
2023/2024	237	328	565



In accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan, initiatives designed to promote women's access to higher education include:

- [interest-free educational loans](#) repayable over seven years, are available to female students pursuing full-time undergraduate degrees to cover tuition costs
- full tuition scholarships for all women enrolled in Master's programs at state-funded higher education institutions.
- [targeted quotas and grant programs](#) are implemented to support women pursuing doctoral studies and opportunities for study at foreign universities. These measures collectively expand access to higher education for women.

The number of female and male students graduating from the Bachelor's and Master's degrees at the Faculty of International Relations is as follows:
