

## **Summary of the Academic Council Meeting (Minutes No. 2)**

At the meeting of the Academic Council of the University of World Economy and Diplomacy held on 30 September 2025 under the chairmanship of the Vice-Rector with participation of vice-rectors, deans, and structural units, issues related to international activities, student internships, state scholarships, scientific projects, and doctoral studies were considered.

### **International Activities (2024–2025 Results and 2025–2026 Plans)**

The report on international cooperation activities was heard and approved. It was decided to:

1. regularly monitor and report international activities quarterly;
2. strengthen compliance with international mobility procedures;
3. expand joint programs with Sukuba and Glasgow Universities;
4. increase the share of foreign students;
5. attract more foreign professors (target: 10%);
6. ensure timely implementation of the international cooperation plan.

### **Student Internship Results (3rd Year Students)**

Reports on practical training outcomes were presented and approved. It was decided to:

1. strengthen cooperation with partner organizations and expand internships;
2. define clear responsibilities for internship organization and supervision;
3. integrate internship monitoring into the Moodle system;
4. develop evaluation criteria for student internship performance;
5. digitalize internship management processes.

### **State Scholarship Competition Results**

Results of the Presidential and named state scholarship selection were reviewed. It was decided to:

1. approve nominated students for national-level selection:
  - A. Presidential Scholarship candidate
  - B. I. Karimov Scholarship candidate
  - C. Navoi Scholarship candidates;
2. submit all documents via the official digital system;
3. ensure further supervision of nomination process.

## **Scientific Project Submission**

A national research project proposal was presented. It was decided to:

1. submit the project on development of a national model for HR policy and public service efficiency to the Innovation Development Agency;
2. ensure coordination and monitoring of project submission.

## **Dissertation Topics of Independent Researchers**

Dissertation topics were reviewed and approved. It was decided to:

1. approve dissertation topics according to annexes;
2. publish approved topics in official OAK bulletin;
3. continue monitoring doctoral research progress;
4. ensure proper academic supervision.
