

Summary of the Academic Council Meeting (Minutes No. 5)

At the meeting of the Academic Council of the University of World Economy and Diplomacy held on December 25, 2025, under the chairmanship of the Rector and with the participation of vice-rectors, deans and heads of structural departments, key issues related to the implementation of Presidential Resolution RP-330 and the university's strategic development were considered.

1. Scientific Activity and Research Development

The Council reviewed the 2025 results of scientific activities under RP-330. The report of Vice-Rector M. Djalalov was heard and accepted. It was decided to:

1. increase the share of faculty with academic degrees;
2. expand participation in international grant-funded projects;
3. promote interdisciplinary research;
4. introduce regular monitoring of doctoral training processes.

2. Spiritual, Educational, and Youth Policy

The report of First Vice-Rector O. Yusupdjanov was approved. The Council set tasks to:

1. broaden student participation in national competitions and initiatives;
2. systematize student publication activity;
3. strengthen coordination and monitoring of youth-related programs.

3. Digital Transformation and Smart University Strategy

Progress in establishing a unified digital ecosystem was acknowledged. The Council approved further measures to:

1. modernize IT infrastructure and improve internet capacity;
2. develop virtual learning environments;
3. gradually integrate artificial intelligence tools into academic and administrative processes.

4. Doctoral Education and Academic Management

Decisions were adopted to:

1. confirm doctoral graduates and approve researcher progression;
2. validate admission results for PhD, DSc, and independent research programs;

3. introduce a regulation for coordinating course coordinators' activities to enhance academic management and student support.
