

Summary of the Academic Council Meeting (Minutes No. 6)

At the meeting of the Academic Council of the University of World Economy and Diplomacy held on January 30, 2026, under the chairmanship of the Rector and with the participation of vice-rectors, deans, and heads of structural units, key issues related to the implementation of Presidential Resolution RP-330 and the university's strategic development were considered.

PR-330 Implementation and 2026 Priorities

The Council reviewed the annual report on PQ-330 implementation and 2026 targets presented by First Vice-Rector A. Umarov. The report was accepted, confirming full completion of 2025 tasks and timely submission of reports to state authorities.

It was decided to:

1. approve 2026 university development targets;
2. introduce systematic monitoring with monthly reporting;
3. strengthen control over performance indicators across all units.

Academic Titles and Human Resources Development

The Council considered proposals for awarding academic titles and strengthening academic staff capacity. It was decided to:

1. approve the awarding of Associate Professor titles to qualified candidates;
2. ensure timely submission of documents to the Higher Attestation Commission;
3. further strengthen faculty development and academic quality.

Admissions and Grant Allocation (2026/2027)

The Council reviewed admission results and state grant distribution parameters. It was decided to:

1. approve admission lists for PhD, DSc, and independent research programs;
2. approve grant allocation parameters by fields and languages;
3. ensure transparent implementation of admission procedures.

Academic Regulations and Institutional Development

Amendments to the Academic Regulations were reviewed and approved. It was decided to:

1. approve the updated Academic Regulations;
2. introduce them into practice from the 2025/2026 academic year;
3. strengthen academic governance and internal quality assurance systems.

Scientific Governance and Financial Support

The Council considered research performance monitoring and additional remuneration for academic staff. It was decided to:

1. approve performance evaluation results;
2. establish additional payments for eligible staff in 2026;
3. continue monitoring research productivity indicators.

Academic Structure and Quality Assurance Framework

The Council approved updated structures of scientific councils and a comprehensive set of institutional documents, including:

1. Quality Assurance Handbook
2. Program Evaluation Regulations
3. Study and Examination Regulations
4. Complaints Policy
5. Student Admission Regulations
6. Learning Agreement
7. Diploma Supplement
8. Staff Recruitment Policy
9. Teaching Load Regulation
10. Data Collection Policy
11. Thesis Writing Regulations
12. Library Resources
13. UWED Career Center

It was also decided to enhance practical training and strengthen faculty-level implementation mechanisms.

Organizational Changes

The Council approved institutional updates, including strengthening digital governance and renaming the “Romano-Germanic Languages” department to the “European and Turkic Languages Department.”
