

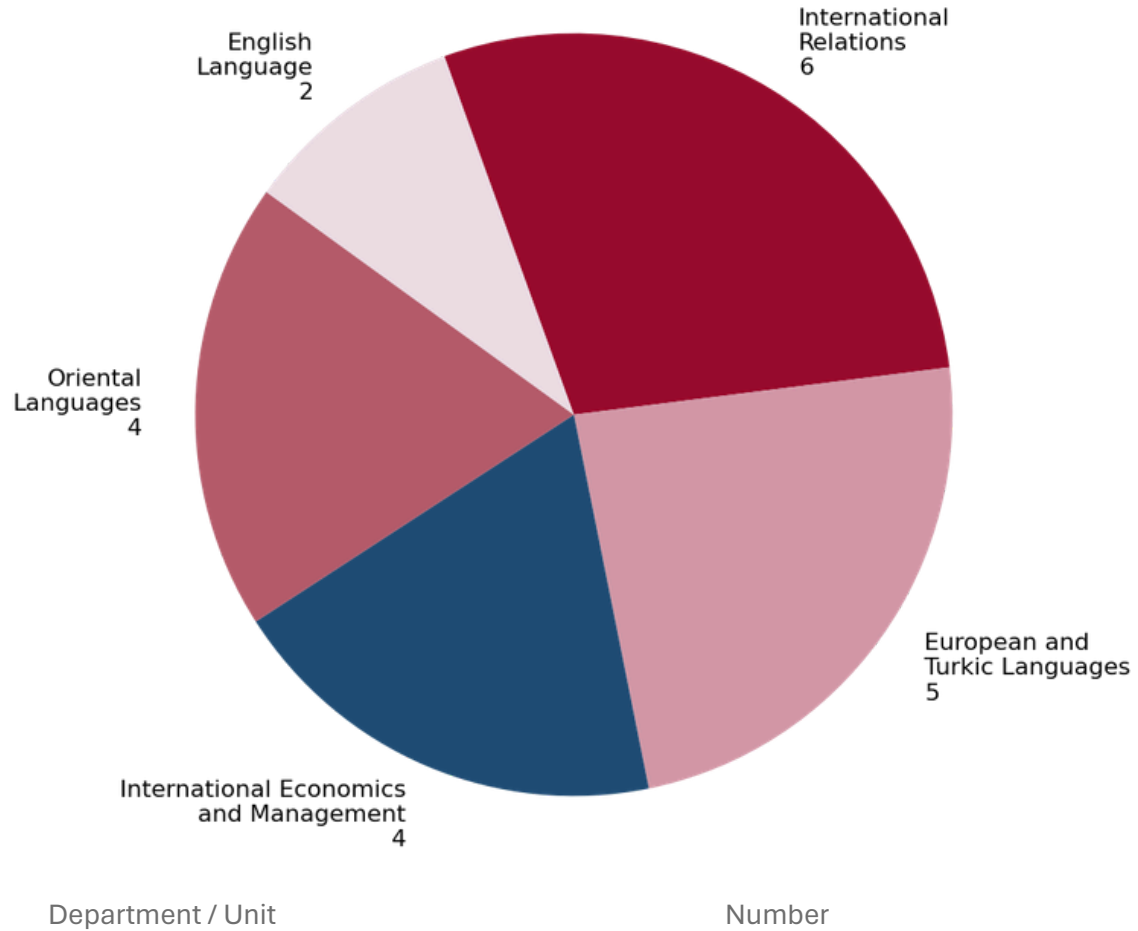


ON THE WORK CARRIED OUT TO ATTRACT

Work by Departments

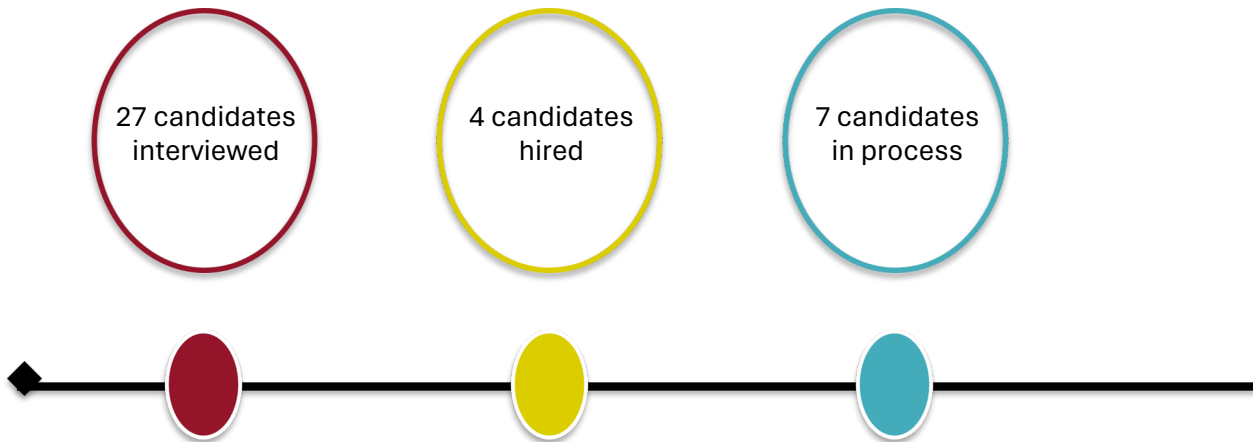
Specific tasks have been assigned to heads of departments to increase the number of foreign professors and teachers. Systematic work is being carried out to identify and attract leading specialists.

- 1 PhD degree from TOP-500 universities;
- 2 Excellent command of English;
- 3 Availability of scientific publications in SCOPUS and Web of Science databases;
- 4 Relevance of the specialisation to UWED fields.



The selection of candidates is carried out in the following stages:

1. Collection and consolidation of documents by the Office of International Academic Cooperation;
2. Initial selection jointly with the Office of Academic and Faculty Affairs;
3. Review by departments;
4. Demo lesson and interview;
5. Final decision-making.



Among these candidates, there are specialists who obtained PhD degrees from prestigious universities such as **Ghent University**(Belgium, QS -162), **Huazhong University of Science and Technology**(China, THE -176), **Durham University**(United Kingdom, QS -94), and **University of Tsukuba** (Japan, QS - 350).
